Do you have suggestions about improving the look and feel of our site?

Needs a little color. Right now it looks very IBMish or old fashion. You will have to skinny the bookmarks if you want the navigation field at the top of the page otherwise us lazy users won't scroll down.
I like the overall look. It is very clean.
Rather than having the job oportunites at the beginning of the front page, could the other information be moved up or information applicable to Mississippi Libraries be listed.
On second glance at looking at the site, is there a way to separate the News announcements from the Job announcements and creating a "News" button from that last blank space? This also relates to content and organization... more so, I would guess.
Separate job postings to "in state" and "out of state". Not easy to scroll the list of just lines of information.
The site looks sleek and clean - very attractive.
Look and feel are great.
Could we standardize the "award recipients". For example, have a recipient link for past president's award and others linked like the Peggy May recipients and Virgia Books Shedd recipients.
The various types of Rebuild Mississippi - Heritage, Legacy, etc. made me think that there were different levels of giving, but there is no explanation about it on any of the pages, just a larger version of the bookmark.
Could we have a page or link off "membership" to the Legacy Club (Lifetime Membership).
More colors or graphics- it looks too dull

The gray type is difficult to read, especially for visually challenged. Otherwise, the colors and design are very attractive.

The "About MLA" part at the bottom of the homepage seems out of place. Maybe it should be a page by itself; link to it immediately below the mla logo at the right.

OR make it the body of the homepage and let News and ML move elsewhere. However, I like the balance the ML cover art provides the rest of the page.

The header and navigation at the top take up too much space. The user has to scroll too far before anything really interesting comes up.

The search feature is not quite right. I received no hits for "author awards."
Can you reorganize the order of the Mississippi Libraries Archives with the most recent at the top?

Not so sure our membership list should be accessible to all. Perhaps a login required to get there (Med. Lib. Assoc. website does this). Also don't see necessity of having committee MEMBERS listed, only officers....Don't want junk mail to increase due to these 2 things.
I think that content will expand naturally as time goes by.
I am impressed.
Where are all the past winners of the various awards? They used to be on the web page.
